Retail will thrive this season, as extravagant boutiques are opening not only along Manhattan's sidewalks, but also on Long Island's Miracle Mile. Join me on a tour of what is new and exciting this season.

**On Magnificent Madison Avenue,** luxe shoemaker **Allen Edmonds** has expanded and opened at the northeast corner of 55th Street. Spanish bridal designer **Pronovias** debuted its flagship showroom at 52nd Street, just steps away from the diamonds at Cartier. Brazilian jewelry designer **Jack Vartanian** is opening in the Mark Hotel, number 996. In June, shoppers will excitedly welcome a monolithic flagship from **Anne Fontaine**, at number 677, by 61st Street.

**On Fabulous Fifth Avenue,** Balenciaga's store-within-a-store is now at Bergdorf Goodman, adjacent to **Prada's** shop-in-shop on the third floor.

**Near Teeming Times Square,** in *the New York Times* building, 40th Street and Eighth Avenue, **Muji**, sought-after retailer hailing from Japan, will be unveiling a new outpost.

**In Radiant Rockefeller Center,** Allen Edmonds has joined the lineup of luxury shops, which includes **J.Crew, Movado, Sharper Image** and **Tumi**.

**In Sumptuous Soho,** **7 For All Mankind** will host its fashionable denim at 394 West Broadway. Jewels by **Belenky Brothers** will sparkle at 91 Grand, relocated from 151 Wooster. 514 Broadway is being prepped to host **Marciano**, the upscale denim line by Guess Jeans. Sweden's **Dunderdon** has

relocated to a new, larger shop at 25 Howard Street. Icelandic concept store **Kisan, Inc.** will have a first US location at 125 Greene Street, purveying carefully selected goods, ranging from children's toys to household items.

**In Trendy Tribeca**, Hawaii-based boutique **Aloha Rag** brings its designer fashion apparel to 505 Greenwich Street.

**In Unbeatable Noho**, a highly stylized **John Varvatos** boutique has been unveiled in the former CBGB spot, 315 Bowery.

**In the Exciting East Village**, **Den** concept boutique, 11th Street off First Avenue, now features the esteemed **Robert Geller** collection. To the delight of many
