This classic cast-iron building on Greene Street (constructed in 1873) has been reimagined as a "refined" 21st-century condo, and it's where you'll find this full-floor, 2,051-square-foot loft home with wide-plank oak flooring, 10-foot windows and ceilings soaring as high as 14 feet. As currently configured, there are two bedrooms, two "luxurious" bathrooms and a home office to go along with the large entertaining/living/dining space and open Schiffini kitchen with marble island white lacquer cabinetry. The "stunning" apartment is accessed by private keyed elevator and features a 24/7 video doorman.
